## **Event Safeguarding Plan**

- 1. All policies and procedures are up to date, agreed by the committee, publicised and readily available.
- 2. All young people/parents/carers entering the competition will complete a form on registration to account for medical details, leaving the site, photography and social media use.
- The form will have a take away page of information for parents/ carers and older young people including reminders about parent/carer supervision, sun care, safety in the car park, policy availability and Fair Play and will give the name of the welfare officer.
- 4. The Welfare Officer (WO) will ensure that officials are qualified, licensed and checked in accordance with LTA/ABTO regulations.
- 5. The officials will be required to wear an ID card.
- 6. The WO will complete a general a risk assessment pre-event.
- 7. The WO will ensure that the completed event safeguarding checklist is available for officials and is displayed for the public.
- 8. The WO will ensure that a missing child procedure is in place.
- 9. The WO will visit the venue at least once a day and liaise with the officials regarding any safeguarding concerns.
- 10. Volunteers will be known to the WO and officials and closely supervised if they are not already DBS checked. They will be appraised of the safeguarding information.
- 11. DBS checked club volunteers (including the WO) will wear an ID badge.
- 12. The organisers will recommend that all children under 13 have a parent/carer on site who will be responsible for supervision including toilet visits. Given the small numbers of young people entering, then supervision of 2:10 is adequately covered by the number of officials/WO.
