### Club Rules

Appropriate shoes and clothing must be worn on court.

No racquet abuse, swearing or spitting on or around the courts.

No food or chewing gum to be brought on court.

No smoking on the courts or in the clubhouse

No alcohol or glass bottles (unless part of a club organised event)

Take care of all club property

Ensure floodlights are switched off and courts are locked securely when you leave, not forgetting the toilets!

## **Court Etiquette**

Do not walk behind the court while play is in progress.

When changing ends, walk around the net.

Minimise equipment brought on court and ensure any items are in a safe place next to the net post, where they can't become a trip hazard during play.

## **Court Condition**

Aboyne Tennis Club is not able to check these courts on a daily basis and cannot accept responsibility for whether or not conditions are suitable for play.

Players should therefore satisfy themselves before using these courts that conditions are suitable for safe play.
