For those who prefer doubles, matched-ability mix in doubles runs on a Wednesday evening and is run by our Chairman Jeff Gedge. Whilst all abilities are welcome, Jeff organises the games to try to ensure players are put on court with others of a similar ability so all get competitive games. Play starts promptly at 6:30pm and players are then swapped around every half hour at 7pm and 7.30pm.

The committee hope these both add to our club programme by offering the opportunity for more competitive mix-in sessions along with our already well attended general mix-in sessions.

NEW SATURDAY SINGLES SESSIONS

We're just about to run our very first Club afternoon specifically for Singles Play starting on Saturday March 11th.

Aimed at our members who enjoy singles play and feel comfortable playing singles for 2 hours, this will take place every other Saturday between 4:00 and 6:00pm. The session will be organised by one of our coaches, and structured so that players of a similar standard can have a fun tournament at least once a month. There will be 10 bookable spots available for each session so that play can be continuous on the top five courts, and we will email out when booking is live for each session. The session is restricted to Amherst members only (no guests) and is free to attend.

For players in the box leagues, the alternate Saturdays at the same time would be a great opportunity to play one of your matches through the season.

DORDRECHT VISIT

In 2017 Amherst Tennis Club revived the town twinning tennis tournament with Dordrecht Tennis club in Holland. In the 1970s and 80s it was a really big event with many players coming over from their club to play over a weekend and then they reciprocated in Holland.

AMHERST ANNUAL CLUB TOURNAMENT 2023


Monday 12th June - Saturday 24th June
