BYE LAWS

Amendments to Bye Laws

1. Amendments to these Bye Laws must be approved by the Management Committee and shall be posted on the notice board in the Clubhouse and on the Club website as long as they are operative.

Hours of Opening

- 2. The hours of opening of the Clubhouse shall be as follows:
 Daily 8.00 am to 11.30 pm unless alternative arrangements are made by the Management Committee
- 3. The hours of court play shall be from 8.00 am to 10.00 pm.
- 4. The hours of opening of the bar for the supply and sale of intoxicating liquor shall not be outside those permitted by the licensee, namely seven days a week from 10 am to midnight. The actual scheduled bar opening times are detailed on the rota displayed on the bar and these may be extended on an ad hoc basis to cover busy periods, Club and social events by agreement with the Bar Secretary and Management Committee.
- 5. The Clubhouse and bar may be taken over partly or entirely for events and arrangements approved by the Management Committee when members' access to parts may be prohibited or limited. In these cases, notice will be posted in the Clubhouse at least seven days before the event whenever possible.
- 6. The last member to leave the Clubhouse must ensure all windows are closed, heating and lights switched off and all external doors locked. If the booking system shows no one is playing after you please also close the front gates.

General

- 7. No dogs shall be allowed in the Clubhouse or in the grounds unless on a lead or under constant control of the member. Should the dog make a mess, this should be cleaned up by the member immediately.
- 8. Private or commercial notices shall not be exhibited on any Club notice board without the consent of the Secretary.

Tennis

- 10 Only suitable tennis clothing and shoes may be worn when playing. Members are to be responsible for the correct attire of their guests.
- 11 The Club operates an on-line court booking system. All members (Senior and Junior) are entitled to book courts. Members must give way once their session has been completed. All subject to rules displayed on the on-line court booking system.
- 12 Club tournaments shall be arranged by the Head Coach.
- 13 The courts may be taken over partly or entirely for events and arrangements approved by the Management Committee. Members will be notified at least seven days before such an event takes place, whenever possible.
- 14 All members on leaving the courts should ensure all rubbish is put in the bins provided and the court gates are shut. The clay courts must be swept unless too wet.

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Coaching

15 Coaching may only be undertaken on the courts with the consent of the Management Committee and after consultation with the Club's Head Coach.

Juniors

- 16 Juniors have priority on Saturday mornings from 9.00 am to 1.00 pm.
- 17 Juniors under the age of 13 should always be under the supervision of a responsible adult when at the Club and must be collected promptly at the end of coaching sessions. They should not be left unattended in the Clubhouse or grounds.

Tennis Balls

18 Tennis balls for hosted sessions, matches and club tournament finals will be provided by the Club.

Playing Standard

19 Prospective applicants will be invited to join the appropriate category of membership according to their ability.
