As we begin a new tennis season all children under the age of 13 using the courts outside of coaching or organised club activities must be accompanied by a parent or carer. Our chaperone membership, which is free of charge, allows a parent or carer to book a court and accompany their child on court. I would also like to remind parents that juniors (under 18yrs old) are not allowed in the clubhouse unless taking part in coaching or other organised club activities. I urge parents/carers to encourage junior members to respect these rules, so that we can maintain a safe and enjoyable place for all to play.

Mixed Doubles by Sara Heron

The club will once again be running with 4 mixed teams for the York League 2024 season.

This year we will be looking for new captains for our teams and would encourage anyone who is looking to play competitive tennis to consider this role. The captains support me in the selection of the teams each week and are responsible for submitting the team's match results to the League, a much simpler task since the introduction of online submissions. We cannot run 4 teams efficiently without members willing to volunteer in these positions and would therefore encourage you to consider this opportunity to support competitive mixed tennis at the club.

If you are willing to volunteer for a captaincy or would like to know more about the role, please contact me or any member of the committee or indicate on the Availability Form attached to this newsletter.

The league will run with 10 divisions in total with 8, 7 or 6 teams in each division. There are also 2 new teams joining the league this season: Tadcaster and Selby. Home matches will take place on **<u>Tuesday and Wednesday</u>** evenings with a **6.30pm** start and the season will start on Monday 6 May.

Balls in the Clubhouse

Used match balls are available in the clubhouse for club sessions and social tennis. If you use them, please return after use and if wet/damp use the rack on the counter to dry them, rather than putting them back in the tins. We recycle old balls to raise funds for the club. If you have finished with your balls, please pop them in the labelled pink bin in the clubhouse.

Court and Clubhouse maintenance by Gary Carpenter & Chris Howat

The last few months has seen substantial maintenance to Court 3. 'Rejuvenation' of the court, by Replay has involved removal of the old sand and dirt, cleaning the astroturf and laying new sand at a cost of £8 150. This work will prolong the life of the court for a significant number of years. Replay have also revisited to 'Revive' courts 1 & 2 as part of the regular twice-yearly maintenance. It has included moss killing and checking the level of sand, thus extending the life of these courts, too. Even though the courts look good, it is still important that they are dragged prior to being played on to minimise contamination of the sand.

We have also been giving the clubhouse a facelift. Some external painting of woodwork was done by committee members last September. We then engaged a

professional painter and decorator to do the internal work, which was carried out at the end of February. He has recently also completed the external painting of soffits which were just too high for us to undertake!

A monthly Health & Safety assessment continues to be carried out and is posted on the noticeboard in the clubhouse for members. We monitor, review, update and follow LTA policies and guidelines to ensure good practice. Please let a committee member know or email <u>info@artc.org.uk</u> if you notice any damage on or around the courts, or in the clubhouse, or believe anything to be unsafe, so appropriate action can be taken.
