Approval of 26th July Minutes – all approved

Chairman's Comment:

That the committee have been working really hard over the last year and that they should ensure they have a pleasurable time working together as a group over the next few months to make it a more pleasurable experience as well as enjoying their tennis.

Treasurer's Report:

As attached with nothing further to add and no questions raised from the rest of the committee.

Clubhouse Report:

David updated the meeting about his & Tanya's refurbishment project and commented that the £8.7K budget was very low in comparison with the costings investigated so far. Pete advised that the budget could be reviewed. **Justin** has contacts who might be able to help with the cost of replacement carpets.

There is a potential rat problem at the Club – **Justin** will lay some traps at suitable sights and the upstairs lounge will have to remain closed until the issue is resolved. As the Club Tournament is due to start it was agreed that the downstairs lounge could possibly be opened up as a small bar area. A skip needs to be organised to enable all the soft furnishings to be disposed of – **David**

The new lock has been ordered for the disabled toilet door.

The Honour Boards to be updated after the end of the Club Tournament – **Claire**

Grounds Report:

Bob W advised that the major service on the floodlights every 4 years and replacement bulbs cost approx £7k, to replace the lights with LED bulbs would cost between £50k- £60K. The floodlights will all need replacing in 1 – 2 years anyway. The LTA doesn't offer any funding for replacement lights tho we may be able to get a small interest free loan from TLL. The entire issue is to be further investigated along with alternative methods for charging the

membership for use of lights and how to fund this project along with replacing courts 1 & 2 which also need to be done in 2 years time (a further cost of approx. £70k -£80K plus replacement base layer). The repairs to the fencing would also cost £45k. The poles are rotting at the bottom, there are also bricks loose under the wall over court 1.

Subs must also be reviewed in light of the work that needs to be completed as the Club needs to operate within it's means. All maintenance options and finance need to be fully investigated as we need to actively find funding - **Bob W & Pete**. (The current sinking fund will stand at £70K next year.) The club needs to be well maintained to be able to attract new members.

Match captains must ensure that floodlights are taken off "free vend" as soon as matches are completed as otherwise they automatically come on again at 3pm until 9.30pm. (**Gill & Chris**)

Ladies Club Captain's Report:

Report as attached plus Gill advised that it had been a good season and she thanked all the team captains for their support and hard work.

Men's Club Captain's Report:

Report as attached. Both Leics Mixed teams gained promotion this season. The Burton matches were all friendlies so there was no pressure on results.
