PLAYING MEMBERSHIPS – The subscription year begins on 1 March

Family: £310 (Plus £25 Joining Fee per adult)

A Playing Membership for Husband and Wife, partnerships and single parents and as many of their children under the age of 18* years, or those in full time attendance at a recognised educational establishment under the age of 25* years, as they wish to include. On reaching the age of 18* or 25* years of age, as applicable, a child must take up Senior Membership in their own right.

Senior: £155 (Plus £25 Joining Fee)

An individual Playing Membership for persons aged 18* years or over.

Junior: £40 (No Joining Fee)

An individual Playing Membership for persons under the age of 18* years, or under the age of 25* years if in full-time attendance at a recognised educational establishment.

Please note: The Management Committee reserves the right to ask for proof of full-time attendance at a recognised educational establishment, if aged between 18 and 24.

Country: One third of the appropriate subscriptions

A Playing Membership for existing Members with full membership, who have had to move to a new home outside the Kent county boundary. The number of places available shall be limited to ten and will not be included in the total number of persons registered as Playing Members. Country Members may attend and speak at General Meetings of the Club but do not have a vote and are not eligible to represent the Club in league matches.

NON-PLAYING MEMBERSHIPS – The subscription year begins on 1 March

Social: £30

A membership for persons who shall be entitled to use and enjoy all the Club facilities and activities except the playing of tennis.

Annual Subscription Payment & Joining Fee

There is no need to make payment until you are requested to do so by the Membership Secretary.

Your Commitment to the Ground, Clubhouse Maintenance, and Club.

We have 3 Saturday mornings a year where volunteers help to maintain the Courts, Grounds and Clubhouse.

You are not obliged to attend all of these, but at least 1 out of 3 would be appreciated. Do not worry about whether you have the skills – there are jobs for all, such as cleaning the bar, weeding or pruning, painting and decorating, but nothing too heavy – we normally bring in builders for that. All materials and equipment is provided. You will be thanked for your contribution with a free lunch and a drink as well as the knowledge that you have helped the club keep down our running costs. We hope to see you at a session in the forthcoming season! You will receive an email nearer the time for each session from the Maintenance Rep.

We would also appreciate volunteers to operate the bar. Usually on a Wednesday evening or Sunday morning after Club Play for approximately two to 3 hrs. Please look out for an email from our bar manager asking for help.

We also have a strong social section of the club, and willing volunteers to help out at the various functions throughout the year are always appreciated. Please contact our Social Co-Ordinator if you can help, with catering or in organising an event.
