Health And Safety Policy

To support our Health and Safety policy statement we are committed to the following duties:

- undertake periodic risk assessments of the club premises, equipment and activities
- create a safe environment by putting appropriate health and safety measures in place as identified by the assessments
- take all reasonable measures to ensure that members are aware of, understand and follow this policy
- appoint a competent club member to assist with health and safety responsibilities
- take all reasonable measures to ensure that all operating procedures are in place and known by members
- provide access to adequate first aid facilities, telephone and qualified first aider at all times
- report any injuries or accidents sustained during any club activity or whilst on the club premises
- take all reasonable measures to ensure that the implementation of the policy is reviewed regularly and monitored for effectiveness.

As a club member you take part in all activities on the common law basis of “Volenti non fit injuria” i.e. you understand the inherent risks of playing tennis. You also have a duty to:

- take reasonable care for your own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by your actions or inaction
- co-operate with the club on health and safety issues
- correctly use all equipment provided by the club
- not interfere with or misuse any club equipment which may prejudice the health, safety or welfare of yourself or others.
