

200 Club Terms and Conditions

Thank you for your interest in Beckington Tennis Association's 200 Club. The 200 Club is run as a 'Small Society Lottery', as defined in Schedule 11, Part 5 of the Gambling Act 2005. This document provides full details of the lottery, including the information that the above act requires us to provide you.

The 200 Club is registered with Mendip District Council's Licensing Department by Beckington Tennis Association. The registration number is LN/009404594. The draw is managed by Derek Martindale, 47 Goose Street, Beckington, Frome, BA11 6SS.

The 200 Club is a series of lotteries. Each lottery last for one year and consists of four draws which are held in June, September, December and March. 40% of all income will be distributed in prizes and the remainder will be applied for the purposes of Beckington Tennis Association.

Each ticket in each draw costs £7.50.

You may enter the lottery at any point, by entering the remaining draws in the current lottery. The cost of entry will be calculated based on the number of draws remaining.

The prize winners will be drawn at random. There will be three prizes in each draw, the value of which will be determined based on the income from the draw.

The breakdown of prizes is as follows:

- 1st Prize = 50% of the pot
- 2nd Prize = 30% of the pot
- 3rd Prize = 20% of the pot

For example: If there are 200 entries in a draw, the total income would be £1500. £600 of this would be prize money. 1st prize - £300. 2nd prize - £180. 3rd prize - £120.

Entrants may join the lottery by using one of the following methods:

- Complete the application form on-line and pay via PayPal using your PayPal account or Credit Card.
- Download the form to complete and return to Derek Martindale, and pay by cash, cheque or standing order. Cheques should be made payable to Beckington Tennis Association. Please do not send cash via Royal Mail.

If you choose to pay by cash, cheque or PayPal, then you must pay for the remaining draws in the current lottery. This can be determined by the current month of the year:

March - May: 4 Draws Remaining: £30
June - August: 3 Draws Remaining: £22.50
September - November: 2 Draws Remaining: £15
December - February: 1 Draw Remaining: £7.50

On completion of the current lottery, you will be contacted by the Hundred Club Manager to discuss entering the next lottery.

If you choose to pay by standing order, then you should arrange for your standing order to start in April, July, October or January. Your standing order will be for £2.50 per month (hence £7.50 per draw). Your standing order will run continuously, and so you will continue to be entered into successive lotteries until the standing order is terminated.

All entrants must fill in the form below. In the event that your contact details change, it is your responsibility to inform the 200 Club Manager of your new contact details.

All winners will be contacted using the contact details provided to the 200 Club Manager, either on this form, or through subsequent communication. In the event that the 200 Club Manager is unable to contact you with these details when you have won a prize, it is your responsibility to contact the Hundred Club Manager to claim your prize. All prizes not claimed within 12 months will be forfeited.
