ADULT CLUB NIGHTS

We run 4 adult club sessions – Monday afternoon from 2pm, Wednesday am from 10am, Wednesday evening from 6pm and Sunday mornings from 10am.



COMPETITIVE TENNIS

We run 2 teams in the Harrogate League. This year we have teams in div. 1 and 4. (out of 6) These matches are played on weekday evenings at 6.30. We will also be entering teams in the Dales Ladies League in which there are just two divisions. These are generally played on Saturday afternoons at 2pm and take 2 courts. HOW TO BOOK A COURT

If you do play with a non-member, don't forget to pay visitors fees to one of the committee, preferably to Stuart Bentley our treasurer.

VISITORS FEES

Visitors to the club should pay £5 a visit and may pay visitors fees up to 3 times before they must join the club. The visitors' fees will then be deducted from the membership fees.

FLOODLIGHTS

Once the summer nights begin to fade and most matches have ended, members can book a court and use the floodlights in the evening. The cost is £4 an hour. Meters are in the clubhouse.

CHANGING ROOMS

The male and female changing rooms are located next to the Squash courts. They consist of a toilet and shower. The changing rooms are kept locked and the key to them is on a peg on the noticeboard in the pavilion. Please ensure toilets are locked after use and the key is returned to the peg. Children using the changing rooms must be accompanied by a responsible adult. The disabled toilet is clearly labelled and faces the cricket pitch.



JUNIOR COACHING

We are fortunate in having a LTA level 4 coach, Mark Hamilton. Mark runs Junior coaching sessions on Tuesday evenings from 4pm. Mark and Jonathan have undertaken safeguarding training and a DBS police check. Please contact Althea Draper if you would like to book coaching for your child. Non-members can also access these sessions for a term, but must join the club after that. At the present time junior school membership is **FREE**.

Juniors can also play in the Dales Juniors League which is run by Bedale Tennis Club. This league is played against about 6 other clubs in the area and matches are generally held on Friday evenings during the summer.

ADULT COACHING

Jonathan Sadler runs a beginners adult coaching session on Tuesday mornings and intermediate sessions for club members and non-members also run on Tuesday mornings and evening. One to one coaching is also available. Please book a place using the clubspark website.
