



## Men's Captain's report 2021

We resumed normal tennis activity this summer having missed the spring league at the start of this year. The team practice sessions on Monday nights were (and continue to be) well attended, and we're hoping to keep playing through the winter as much as possible.

The summer league results were generally positive –

1<sup>st</sup> team – the 1sts achieved promotion back to the premier league at the first time of asking. The team generally consisted of Tom Barton, Euan Forbes, Jack Malone and Harry Malone, but there were also some really important contributions from Jon Baber, Joe Porter, Louis Edge, Phil Shakeshaft and Matt Dunn.

2<sup>nd</sup> team – the 2nds came 3<sup>rd</sup> and just missed out on promotion from division 4. Several players were new to this team, and with more consistent pairings, promotion was a real possibility. 3<sup>rd</sup> team – the 3rds likewise had a strong season and came close to promotion, narrowly missing out, with several new players playing their first league season for the club. Alongside Captain Chris Rhodes: Dan Williams, Lee Cassell, Matt Dunn, Brian Connell and Fil Calcutt were the regulars, while Duncan Mayne, Collen Mhlanga and Alex Grafton also stepped up this season.

4<sup>th</sup> team – the 4ths had a very solid season having achieved promotion in 2019, consolidating their place in division 6 with a strong 4<sup>th</sup> place finish.
