

CONSTITUTION

1. The Club shall be called the "Bingham Lawn Tennis Club."
2. Its objects shall be to provide tennis for its members and such social and recreative pursuits as may be deemed desirable by the General Committee.
3. The Officers shall consist of a Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and Club Captain, who shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting.
4. The Club shall be controlled by a General Committee consisting of the Officers and at least four senior members who shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting. The General Committee shall meet as required and the proceedings at such meetings shall be duly recorded in a Minute Book. At Meetings of the General Committee five members shall form a quorum.
5. The property and assets of the Club shall be vested in the General Committee. The General Committee shall have power to suspend or expel any member deemed guilty of conduct prejudicial to the good name of the Club. The General Committee shall have power to co-opt or to fill vacancies as they arise between Annual General Meetings.
6. A register of members of the Club shall be kept by the Secretary.
7. The annual subscriptions of the Club shall be fixed at the Annual General Meeting.
8. The Annual General Meeting shall be held not later than November 30th in each year. The Secretary shall give seven ^{days} clear notice of such meeting to all members. The Financial Statement, the Chairman's Report and the Club Captain's Report shall be received by the Meeting., which will also elect the Officers and the General Committee by ballot and transact any other business.
9. An Extraordinary General Meeting may be convened by the General Committee when deemed desirable, or by written request (to the Secretary) of fifteen members. The Secretary shall give seven days clear notice to all members of such Meeting, at which twenty members shall form a quorum, within one calander month of such request.
10. The General Committee shall cause to be kept proper books of account which shall be audited annually. The General Committee shall authorise cheques to be signed by any two or three Officers nominated by the Committee.
11. No alteration of this Constitution shall be made except at the Annual General Meeting or at an Extraordinary General Meeting called for that purpose and only when supported by two thirds of those present and voting at such Meeting. Notice of proposed alteration to the Constitution must be given in writing to the Secretary by 30th September in each year and notified to members on Notice of Meeting.
12. Any other matters not governed by the foregoing Constitution shall be dealt with by the General Committee whose decision shall be final and binding.
