Age of Supervision Children under 12 years should be supervised by a parent/carer whilst at the Club except when attending coaching lessons, tennis camps, matches or fun sessions. Use of Courts We have 5 all-weather, polymeric, floodlit courts available all year round for members and pay-n-play visitors. All courts are accessed via 2 gates with coded padlocks. **Visitors** should use the double gates at court 5 (email code for each on-line booking). **Members** should use the single gate at courts 1/2 - codes and changes will be sent out via email. **Scoreboards** are kept in the clubhouse. **Floodlights** are available until 10pm when they will automatically switch off - prepare to stop and lock up before this time. The portacabin key is kept in a locked coded security box beside the door. Please let down the nets after play. Please ensure the gates and the portacabin door are locked securely when you leave. **No studded shoes** are allowed on the courts. Evening winter play is subject to a surcharge to cover the cost of lights.

How to Book Courts are available for play at most times and can be pre-booked using the Clubspark app or at www.clubspark.lta.org.uk/BlairgowrieLTC. If floodlights are required, please contact Susan Whiteford 07745 427572, or team captains.
