PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOS AND PUBLICITY (extract from Privacy Policy)

The Club has 'legitimate interests' for processing personal information about individuals we interact with, including photographs/videos. We need to process personal data in order to:

- market products and services (including Wimbledon tickets, BTC merchandise, performance and participation programmes, coaching courses and events), and promote tennis generally;
- ensure the security of LTA events and premises, including by recording individuals' photographs as part of event accreditation
 processes and capturing individuals' images, using CCTV monitoring;

FOR YOUR INFO - AGE OF SUPERVISION

Children under 12 years must be supervised by a responsible adult whilst at the Club. If children are not participating in organised club coaching/playing sessions their safety and welfare at the courts is the responsibility of their parents/carers.

High school aged children (12 years and over) can play on the courts without supervision but are expected to behave appropriately at all times - see Codes of Conduct. Refer to the Safeguarding policy for more details.

FOR YOUR INFO - WhatsApp COMMUNITY GROUP for children/adults-at-risk

To communicate effectively about **junior coaching**, **activities and competitions**, we plan to trial a new **WhatsApp Community**. It's a tiered structure with improved privacy settings. It allows direct communication with children/adults at risk <u>plus</u> parents/carers.

The top Community level is 1-way announcements only from coaches. The groups beneath the Community level are interactive 2-way chats and may comprise eg. family groups, red/orange/green/yellow ball groups, U16 Team etc. All members can post, reply and interact within each group level.

<u>Most importantly</u>, these groups have added privacy and an audit trail. *In practice this means that your phone number is visible only to community admins, people who have saved you as a contact already, or those who have your number from other chats.* All other members of the group will not see your full phone number in the community group chat. An audit trail is vital for our LTA registration and for safeguarding reasons.

The choice to **opt in** is entirely yours and, of course, you can always leave the chat if you no longer want to be included for whatever reason. It remains your responsibility to ensure that your family's privacy settings are compatible.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

Thank you. Once your forms are complete and payment is received:

- 1. You will be able to access all 5 courts and the clubhouse. The court gates and clubhouse are accessible using coded padlocks. The codes (updated regularly) will be sent on the weekly What's On email.
- 2. You can reserve courts on ClubSpark, attend social tennis sessions, family days, BBQs, themed tennis days, Bring-A-Friend etc all for free! There's a lot going on and we don't want you to miss out on all the fun. You can bring guests up to a maximum of 4 visits/year (guest fees apply). Members are responsible for ensuring payment is made @£4/hour.
- 3. You can also enter competitions and attend coaching, Cardio and Walking tennis sessions (fees may apply).

STATEMENT OF ACCEPTABLE USE OF INTERNET AND SOCIAL MEDIA

The Club understands the importance of online communication for children's and young people's development. However, we recognise that relevant safeguards need to be put in place to ensure children and young people remain safe while online or using social media. We ask that all parents / carers spend a few minutes reading through and discussing this statement with their child/adult at risk and ask that you both sign and then return this form to the Membership Secretary.

*Agreement of child / adult at risk

- 1. I will be responsible for my behaviour when using my phone at the Club, including the content I access and how I conduct myself.
- 2. I will not deliberately create, browse or access material that could be considered offensive or illegal. If I accidentally come across any such material, I will report this to a member of staff.
- 3. I will not use social media or the internet to send anyone material that could be considered threatening, offensive, upsetting, bullying or that is illegal.
- 4. I understand that I should only use the Club's official social media or website communication channels to contact them and should not seek out individual members of staff or coaches.
- 5. I understand that all my use of internet and social media is potentially visible to everyone and that any issues involving my behaviour online may be addressed by my coach or other staff members at the club.
- 6. I will not give out my personal information (such as name, age, address or telephone number) online, or that of anyone else.
- 7. I will not share my passwords with anyone else.
- 8. I will not arrange to meet someone that I have met online unless accompanied by a member of staff or parent.
- 9. I understand that these rules are designed to keep me safe, and if they are not followed my parents may be contacted.
- 10. I will avoid using my mobile phone during activities as I understand that it will have an impact on my safety and my opportunity to learn and achieve.
- 11. I am aware that if I am experiencing bullying behaviour or abuse online, I can contact the Club Welfare Officer.
- 12. I know I can contact Childline on 0800 11 11 or at childline.org.uk if I have any worries about something I've seen or experienced online.
