



# Format for Club Sessions

To give everyone the chance to mix in and play the following format is being used at Club Sessions:

If there are **exactly a multiple of 4 players** who turn up to play:

- **Full sets** can be played with normal deuce
- If more than one group of four on court, then play stops on all courts when one group completes a set, to allow mix of players for the next set
- Where two games in play (e.g. courts 4 & 5), winners court 5 move up and split, losers court 4 move down and split
- Where more than two games in play (e.g. courts 1, 2, 4 & 5), Winners courts 2, 4 & 5 move up and split, losers courts 1, 2 & 4 move down and split. Court 1 winners and court 5 losers remain on the same courts.

If there **any other number of players** turn up or the total number exceeds the capacity of the available courts, or an additional player arrives later in session:

- **Fast Four sets** to be played – First to four games with sudden death deuce
- When one court finishes, the person(s) waiting to play mixes in with those players, with the rest sitting off temporarily.
- When another court finishes, the person(s) sitting off will then mix in with those players and others sit off
- Because Fast fours play is generally completed quicker than traditional sets, the matches will vary in timespan and so players sitting off should not have to wait long to get back on court
- Where all courts finish at the same time, the players can all be mixed around
