

CHANGING ROOMS CODE OF CONDUCT

Blofield Tennis Club (BTC) strives to ensure that all children, young people and adults at risk are safeguarded from abuse and have an enjoyable tennis experience.

This document sets out the BTC code of conduct for use of the clubs changing rooms.

The Club has two small changing rooms for use by players at the Club. These are clearly marked with Male and Female signs and as far as possible should be used accordingly.

Space is limited and so only one person should use a changing room at a time.

Care should be taken to ensure that the changing room is vacant before entering.

Children under 9 years of age should be supervised by their parent/guardian.

Ensure that all items of equipment/clothing are removed from the changing room when you have finished, to allow others to use the facility.

Remove any rubbish and put it in the bins provided next to the sink in the kitchen area.

Do not put any dressings/soiled dressings in the bin, instead take them home and dispose of them responsibly.
