"Agreement Terms" – BLTC personal data

As a member you understand the above statement and agree that BLTC may retain your personal data to;

- record your BLTC and BTM memberships
- communicate with you and to send you e mails
- you agree that your telephone number and/or e mail address may be disclosed to other BLTC members to arrange matches.

Why do BLTC retain personal data ?

BLTC retains your personal data in order to;

- maintain a record of BLTC members,
- maintain a record of British Tennis Members (BTM) linked to BLTC,
- communicate with you, and
- send you emails periodically to keep you informed as to BLTC news and activities
- maintain via ClubSpark your personal data security

BLTC requests your agreement to retain and use your personal data for these purposes but you do have the option to withdraw your consent at anytime time.

BLTC does not share your personal data with third parties except it uses the MailChimp online platform to send e mails.

If you cease to be a member, BLTC retains your personal data for one year before erasing it.
