UPDATED CODE OF CONDUCT DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

BE SAFE – BE MINDFUL AND MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING – SANITISE

We welcome all club members to our courts but we MUST all adhere to the following code of conduct to meet with Government, Telford and Wrekin Council, LTA and Venue Rules. Please ensure you have explained and checked that your children have understood the following regulations.

The toilets are now in use. Please come changed ready to play as changing rooms are still out of use.

1) Anyone attending the club (including players, coaches, staff and any other visitors), should undergo a pre-attendance self-assessment for any COVID19 symptoms using the information on the NHS website before leaving home. No-one should leave home to participate in tennis if they, or someone they live with, has symptoms of COVID -19, currently recognised as any of the following:

- A high temperature
- A new, continuous cough
- A loss of, or change to, their sense of smell or taste.

If you, or anyone you live with, have one or more of any of these symptoms you should not attend any sporting activity, even if your symptoms are mild. You must follow NHS guidance on self-isolation. If you have been informed that you need to self isolate by NHS Test and Trace, you must do so.

- 2) All courts must be booked online. All participants should be listed online. Using the QR code will support the NHS Test and Trace.
- 3) Follow public health guidelines for hygiene.
- 4) Maintain social distancing (2m rule) where possible.
- 5) No shaking hands or physical contact with other players.
- 6) Only handle your own racket and clean equipment after use.
- 7) Allow others to leave before you enter the court - wait away from the gates. Players are now allowed access beyond the entrance gate.
- 8) The nets are set at the correct height please do not alter, and report any damage or net issues
- 9) Max group size for adults and children subject to safe capacity for venue/activity in each coaching/organised group.
- 10) Spectating permitted – limit subject to COVID-19 secure capacity of venue & risk assessment.
- 11) Please use sanitiser provided at the entrance gate and inside the clubhouse.
- 12) The benches in the court area are now in use.
- 13) There are **no** bins please take all rubbish home.
- 14) A first aid kit and accident book is available in the clubhouse. Please take home all medical waste.

15) If you have to use the lights, please sanitise before and after entry, fill in sheet, scan the QR code and disinfect contact surfaces.

The Committee reserve the right to close the Courts with immediate Notice. Thank you, and your cooperation will help to keep us all safe.
