UPDATED CODE OF CONDUCT DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

BE SAFE – BE MINDFUL AND MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING – SANITISE

We welcome all club members to our courts but we **MUST** all adhere to the following code of conduct to meet with Government, Telford and Wrekin Council and LTA Rules. Please ensure you have explained and checked that your children have understood the following regulations. **There are no toilets!**

THE CLUBHOUSE REMAINS CLOSED AND OUT OF BOUNDS TO ALL!*

- 1) Anyone attending a venue (including players, coaches, staff and any other visitors), should undergo a pre-attendance self-assessment for any COVID₁₉ symptoms using the information on the NHS website before leaving home. No-one should leave home to participate in tennis if they, or someone they live with, has symptoms of COVID -19, currently recognised as any of the following: - A high temperature - A new, continuous cough - A loss of, or change to, their sense of smell or taste. Should an individual have demonstrated any such symptoms, they must follow NHS and PHE guidance on self-isolation. Anyone waiting for a test result for themselves or within their bubble may not attend.
 - 2) Online booking for **members** only. All participants should be listed online and use the QR code. Non-members **cannot** use the courts. Any visitors to the courts/clubhouse must inform a committee member prior to attendance for test and trace purposes.
 - 3) Follow public health guidelines for hygiene
 - 4) Maintain social distancing (2m rule) where possible. Informal social play is limited to a maximum of 6
 - 5) No shaking hands or physical contact with other players
 - 6) Only handle your own racket and clean equipment after use
 - 7) Allow others to leave before you enter the court - wait away from the gates. Only players and coaches are allowed access beyond the entrance gate, disperse as soon as possible with no gatherings of more than 6, no mixing with other households.
 - 8) The nets are set at the correct height please do not alter, and report any damage or net issues
 - 9) Up to 12 people (15 children) allowed in each coaching/organised group to include the coach, staying 2m apart where possible.
 - 10) Please ensure the gate handles and padlock are wiped before you enter and after you leave, unless someone else is still playing
 - 11) The benches in the court area are out of use
 - 12) Regrettably spectating is not allowed, those with young children are permitted only one person per household to wait in the designated grassed area if necessary. Non-members are not allowed on the premises. Please do not wait in the players zone or enter the courts
 - 13) There are **no** bins please take all rubbish home
 - 14) A first aid kit and accident book is available in the plastic bunker adjacent to Court 4, for emergencies only. Please take home all medical waste.
- Use of lights are discouraged for now as the Clubhouse remains closed. If you have to use the lights please sanitise before and after entry, fill in sheet, scan the QR code and disinfect contact surfaces.

The Committee reserve the right to close the Courts with immediate Notice. Thank you, and your cooperation will help to keep us all safe.
