
Bovingdon and Flaunden Tennis Club – Covid Match protocols

We want to welcome all players to our club but the safety of all players is our top priority. Please therefore be aware of our protocol below before you visit our Tennis Club and please comply with all government and LTA guidance associated with COVID-19 (social distancing, hand hygiene and so on) while visiting.

Before you Arrive

1. Please bring appropriate clothing with you. The Clubhouse will not be available for shelter in the event of inclement weather and you may need to use cars if necessary.
2. We will have cleaned key areas of the clubhouse and set the net heights to the correct levels, set out scoring posts where necessary and prepared for your visit. This should allow us to minimise contact points you will encounter at the club.

When you Arrive

1. Please use the Hand sanitiser available adjacent to the clubhouse before and after play.
2. Please observe appropriate social distancing when utilising the available seating.
3. You may take your kit to the court or if the weather is inclement, you may leave it under the clubhouse roof. We are not allowing access to the club for the storage of kit.
4. Only the toilet facilities in our clubhouse are available. Upon arrival, you will be made aware of the individuals within our team that will arrange access. Please only access the clubhouse with the permission of our team.
5. A mask **MUST** be worn on entry to the clubhouse.
6. Please use the wipes provided to wipe anything that you have touched within the clubhouse. Do not dispose of wipes in the toilet but use the bin provided.
7. If scoreboards are in use, we will nominate one person in each rubber to update them to limit physical contact.
8. We have an external water tap to the right of the clubhouse, which you are welcome to use.

During the Match

1. Always retain social distancing including ensuring safe changing of ends.

After the Match

1. Well done on completing your match but please avoid unnecessary physical contact such as handshakes. Please use the hand sanitiser available.
2. We will keep a record of the names and phone numbers of all players for track and trace purposes which will be retained for 28 days.
3. Unfortunately we do not feel it appropriate to offer post match refreshments at this time. You are welcome to bring your own refreshments or, if appropriate and safe, we may arrange to go for a socially distanced drink at a local pub after the match.
