Bramford Tennis Club is a small and friendly village club with 3 hard courts in excellent condition, 2 of which are currently floodlit. The club sits at the heart of the Bramford village community (post code is IP8 4HU) in Ipswich on land owned by the Bramford Parish Council and looked after by an elected Playing Field Management Committee (PFMC) of volunteers.

The club has grown over the last 5 years from just 9 members to 150 members, representing all ages and backgrounds. We want to continue to develop the club facilities to support the ever growing local community so that we can help people live healthier and happier lifestyles.



WHY US

IBramford Tennis Club is located in the centre of a small but growing village community (IP8) on the westside outskirts of Ipswich. The club has built a strong reputation over recent years and attracts members and casual players from a wide area including from a number of rural communities that are up to 12 miles away (see radius map)

Bramford is adjacent to some of the more deprived areas of Ipswich i.e IP1 & IP2 which both have an IMD rating of <=3. Our inexpensive membership rates, casual pay & play and nonmember coaching options however still help to attract players from these areas and the floodlight project will allow us to extend additional court time with priority access to those from disadvantaged communities through our planned weekly "Tennis for Free" initiative session (note 1)

PHASE 1 (YEARS 1-3)

As a minimum we want to see Bramford Tennis Club continue to grow so that it can keep pace with new housing developments in the area, offering an important way for people to maintain a healthy lifestyle.

Retractable floodlights - Key to growth will be the introduction of a floodlighting solution to Court 1 (some fence strengthening may also be required) as this will allow us to extend winter play across 3 courts rather than 2 courts

Clubhouse/secure storage - A new secure storage/clubhouse facility will help to create a social hub for people to stay behind and socialise and will also allow secure storage of important club assets e.g. ball machine, coaching equipment etc.



Note - Planning approvals are already in place for this phase


Note 1 - Our focus at this stage is very much on achieving the Phase 1 goals. Later phases will only be fully investigated after phase 1 is completed

PHASE 2 (YEARS 3-5)

In phase 2 we would look to updgrade remaining floodlights to LED, complete the replacement or upgrade of all perimeter fencing (concluding any works that weren't able to be completed under phase 1). The new fencing solution could incorporate "SMART" gate access technology for "pay and play" purposes and high quality "rebound" wall(s)

Additionally, we would repair and repaint all courts which will extend the life of the courts for a further 5 years. The repaint could also include some additional lines for other **Tennis** related sports e.g. Pickleball, Touch Tennis etc






PHASE 3 (YEARS 5-10)

Longer term, our ambitious redevelopment plan would look to introduce a court canopy on at least one court to allow year round play whatever the weather (this facility could be rented out to generate additional revenue) plus on-court technology to enhance the playing experience

We could also be more ambitious with the clubhouse, creating a social hub cafe either by extending the tennis clubhouse or working in collaboration with the PFMC to redevelop the existing pavillion.

Note - The cafe would be open to the whole community and funds raised could be re-invested in the facilities.
