not swearing on the court or abusing any person, racquet or court equipment. Please offer encouragement not criticism!

encouraging fair play and discouraging disputes over calls. If in doubt the ball is IN! If you cannot agree, offer a let.

being suitably attired, and wearing non-abrasive tennis shoes to protect the court.

waiting until a suitable break in play to walk behind a court, enter or leave a court and then doing so as quickly as possible, closing the gate.

retrieving balls for your partner and your opponents and doing so with good humour!

Noticing when balls from another court have come over onto your court and returning them promptly to the other court during a suitable break in play. If retrieving a ball, please wait for a suitable break in play.

We leaving the Clubhouse and courts as you would expect to find them, litter free, clean and tidy. **Please take your rubbish home with you!**

Revealed the Club house secure, locked up and lights off. If you have unlocked the clubhouse it is your responsibility to lock it back up, or to ensure that there is someone else with a key who will lock up.

weighted turning your phone to silent

talking quietly near courts that are in use.

the club is a non-profit organisation; NO paid coaching is allowed without the prior permission of the Committee : Official club coach is Alan Cash
