

ADULT MEMBERSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. By agreeing to our terms and conditions applicants are agreeing to join and pay for membership of Broughton Padel at Broughton and District Club for one full year from the date of purchase.
2. If using the direct debit option, applicants are agreeing to pay the total amount in one payment. Should a member cancel their monthly direct debit option before the full amount is paid, they agree to inform the Broughton & District Club Membership Secretary – Mr. B Lunn - and arrange a different method of payment for the fee.
3. Personal data will be processed by Broughton Padel and Broughton and District Club, during the membership period according to Broughton Padel GDPR policies and Broughton and District Club's Privacy Policy (both are available to read at: - <https://clubspark.lta.org.uk/BroughtonPadel/Policies>)
4. By joining Broughton Padel members agree that their image, if captured during participation in Broughton Padel activities and events, may be used for promotion and communication purposes. If members do not wish to have their image included, please contact info@broughtonpadel.uk
5. By agreeing to this membership, you are confirming that you are fit to play Padel and not playing against the advice of GP or Hospital Doctor.
6. New Padel members please note: To be recognised by the LTA, it is necessary to become LTA Advantage members. Go <https://www.lta.org.uk/advantage/> for details.

Members cannot enter the Wimbledon ballot without LTA Advantage membership or use the court booking system.

7. Two days after completion of the online application, the applicant will be deemed to be a temporary member of Broughton & District Club and Broughton Padel until his/her application is approved or rejected by Broughton & District Club Committee and payment is received. Should the applicant not be accepted for membership, all monies so deposited will be refunded.
8. Members may cancel their membership up to 14 days after signing up with full refund. No refund will be given to cancellations after this time. Any refund given will not include any court booking fees paid in the 14-day period.
9. Members may not request their membership be suspended for any period of time during the currency of the membership for any reason, including injury preventing play.

11. A separate application is required for each applicant/member. The only exception is where the member joins under the Group Membership option.
12. Club membership entitles the member to use the bar at all opening times and participate in the activities of the Snooker, Bridge, Pétanque and Drama Sections.
