

## Court Hire Terms and Conditions for Broughton and District Tennis Club (B&D Tennis Club)

For the purpose of this document the 'hirer' refers to the person whose name is used to book the court. The 'user' refers to the person/people playing tennis on the court at the time the court was booked.

- The hirer may cancel the court via the clubspark website with a full refund up to 6
  hours in advance, after this time the hirer will be charged, whether the court is used
  or not.
- 2. All users, players and supporters at B&D Tennis Club have a responsibility to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner, consistent with the following Code of Conduct:
  - Respect every player or supporter regardless of their gender, age, ability, cultural background or religion
  - Play by the rules and encourage fair play
  - Be respectful in dealings with officials, coaches, players and supporters
  - Engage in positive behaviour
  - Do not use abusive language
  - Wear appropriate tennis attire and suitable sports shoes (no black soles) when using the courts
  - Be considerate of the safety and wellbeing of other players

Any person who does not abide by this Code of Conduct can be asked to leave B&D Tennis Club. B&D Tennis Club reserves the right to decline or cancel court hire bookings by players who have breached the code of conduct.

- 3. Court users shall not act in a manner which causes injury, damage or distress to any property or person including other users of the Facilities.
- 4. Children U16 must be supervised by an appropriate adult whilst using the facilities.
- 5. The Hirer shall be responsible for ensuring that the behaviour of all non-member court users associated with the booking complies with these Terms and Conditions and shall be jointly liable for any damage caused by such users.
- The court booking facility is free for members. Only members who have paid their annual subscriptions and joined using the online facility are able to book a court for free.
- 7. Chaperones and parents of juniors may book courts for free but are not able to book courts after 6pm Monday to Thursday except in the Summer when they can book Courts 6 and 7.

## 8. Members must:

- Cancel any unwanted bookings online using the website or the app or if you are struggling by emailing us.
- Members may continue to turn up and play without booking a court, but if there is a booking at the same time, then the priority goes with the players with a booking.
