Broughton and District Club Tennis Newsletter Autumn 2023


Hi Everyone,

Recent LTA Safeguarding Evaluation

The LTA have completed their evaluation of the effectiveness of safeguarding measures in place at Broughton and District Tennis Club and were impressed with the procedures that we currently have and how we actively engaged with the process. The final report has highlighted a few changes that we should make – including ensuring we adopt the LTA's new policies for 2023 (all 8 of them!) including a new one on staying safe online and setting up a dedicated email address where safeguarding issues can be raised. As soon as we have got these documents in place and signed off by the committee, we will provide members with more detail of the new safeguarding procedures via a special safeguarding email.

Members Safeguarding Survey

Thank you to the 49 members (15% of the total membership) who completed the LTA safeguarding survey – the LTA representative, who did the evaluation, said the norm is @10% so we had above norm engagement. 87.7% of the 49 members said they knew how to contact the Welfare Officer. Lisa's information is included on this page next to her photo; her details and details of how to contact the LTA are on the safeguarding page of our website; they are also displayed on the noticeboard in the pavilion.

The responses were anonymous, but if anyone wants to follow up on any areas they raised in the survey, with Lisa, or any of the committee members, please be assured that all conversations will, as always, be totally confidential and of no detriment whatsoever to the person raising the concern. This is also the case for any queries or concerns members wish to raise at any time. Rest assured that the committee of volunteers at Broughton and District Club are always striving to do their best to provide you with top class facilities and a safe environment to enjoy playing tennis. As such the results of the survey will be reviewed at our next committee meeting and as always, we will do our best to improve any areas that have been highlighted as areas of concern.
