

CODE of CONDUCT

All volunteers, committee members, coaches and club members agree to:

- Prioritise the well-being of children, and vulnerable adults, always;
- Treat all children and vulnerable adults fairly and with respect;
- Be a positive role model. Act with integrity, even when no one is looking;
- Help to create a safe and inclusive environment both on and off court;
- Not allow any rough or dangerous behaviour, bullying or the use of bad or inappropriate language;
- Report all allegations of abuse or poor practice to the club Welfare Officer;
- Not use any sanctions that humiliate or harm a child or adult at risk;
- Value and celebrate diversity and make all reasonable efforts to meet individual needs;
- Keep clear boundaries between professional and personal life, including on social media;
- Have the relevant consent from parents/carers, children and adults before taking or using photos and videos;
- Refrain from making physical contact with children or adults unless it is necessary as part of an emergency or congratulatory situation (e.g., handshake / high five);
- Refrain from smoking and consuming alcohol during club activities or coaching sessions;
- Ensure roles and responsibilities are clearly outlined and everyone has the required information and training;
- Avoid being alone with a child or adult at risk unless there are exceptional circumstances;
- Refrain from transporting children or vulnerable adults, unless required as part of a club activity (e.g., away match) and there is another adult in the vehicle;
- Not abuse, neglect, harm or discriminate against anyone; or act in a way that may be interpreted as such;
- Not have a relationship with anyone under 18 for whom they are coaching or responsible for;
- Not have a relationship with anyone over 18 whilst continuing to coach or be responsible for them.

All parents, guardians and carers agree to:

- Positively reinforce your child and show an interest in their tennis;
- Use appropriate language at all times;
- Be realistic and supportive;
- Never ridicule or admonish a child for making a mistake or losing a match;
- Treat all children, adults, volunteers, committee members, officials, coaches, and club members with respect;
- Behave responsibly at the venue; do not embarrass your child;
- Accept officials' decisions and do not go on court or interfere with matches;
- Encourage your child to play by the rules and teach them that they can only do their best;
- Deliver and collect your child punctually to/from the venue;
- Ensure your child has appropriate clothing and refreshments for the weather conditions;
- Ensure that your child understands their code of conduct;
- Adhere to your venue's safeguarding policy, diversity and inclusion policy, rules and regulations;
- Provide emergency contact details and any relevant information about your child including medical history on joining and when asked for it by an official, coach or committee member.

All children are expected to:

- Be friendly, supportive, and welcoming to other children and adults;
- Play fairly and honestly;
- Respect club staff, volunteers and Officials and accept their decisions;
- Behave, respect, and listen to your coach;
- Take care of your equipment and club property;
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, culture, religion, or sexual identity;
- Not use bad, inappropriate, or racist language, including on social media;
- Not bully, intimidate, or harass anyone, including on social media;
- Not smoke, drink alcohol or drugs of any kind on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions or events;
- Talk to the club Welfare Officer about any concerns or worries they have about themselves or others.

This Code of Conduct should be interpreted in a spirit of integrity, transparency, and common sense, with the best interests of children and vulnerable adults as the primary consideration.

Intentional failure to comply with and uphold the standards set out in this code of conduct could result in a member's suspension or expulsion from the club with no refund of fees paid, subject to committee ruling.
