COVID-19 SAFETY MEASURES from 29th March 2021

The Club requires that all members and those who visit the facilities at Calne Tennis Club comply with the formal guidance for tennis on the LTA's website. All those entering the courts are to complete the registration book by the Clubhouse.

The safety measures below take account of LTA Guidance dated 26th March 2021 and cover the resumption of outdoor tennis activity from 29th March 2021.

ONLY MEMBERS OF CALNE TENNIS CLUB MAY USE THE COURTS

The following tennis activities are permitted:

- Both singles and doubles play with people from outside your household, provided you remain 2 metres apart as far as possible; so, four people from different households can play doubles.
- For Informal social play, group size is limited to a maximum of 6 people (or 2 households) **BY LAW**. A group made up of 2 households can include more than 6 people, but only where all members of the group are from the same 2 households or the same support/childcare bubbles.
- For all group play, there is to be no interchanging of players between groups and players should continue to maintain social distancing from those that they do not live with or share a support bubble.
- Groups larger than those above, including tennis tournaments, league matches and club competitions, are not currently permitted at Calne but the club will publish measures to permit these soon.

Key Safety notes and measures

If you have played at our club and develop symptoms of COVID-19 then you are required to follow the Government's 'test and trace' guidelines which are contain on the www.gov.uk

- Undertaking any activity, including tennis, has the potential for increased risk of infection or transmission of COVID-19. The Club advises you to read the Government's guidance on staying safe outside your home.
- Before you, or anyone with you, attends the club, you must undertake a pre-attendance self-assessment for COVID-19 symptoms using the information on the NHS website before leaving home, then follow guidance.
- Do not come to the courts if you have a positive COVID-19 test, or are symptomatic, or live in a household with someone who has a possible or confirmed COVID-19 infection, or if you have been in direct contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, or if you have been asked to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace, until your self-isolation period is over.
- Spectating is not permitted. Attendance of a non-participating parent/guardian/carer is permitted but they are to remain off court and are limited to one per player.
- Where supervision takes place, this is subject to the 'rule of 6' (the person supervising is counted as 1 of the 6), and to the maintenance of social distancing from people not in their household or bubble.
- All 4 courts may be used simultaneously.
- Bring your own first aid kit for minor incidents. For major incidents, Beversbrook staff will attend, so alert both them and emergency services directly in such an event.
- Beversbrook toilets may be used. The clubhouse and Beversbrook changing rooms are unavailable.
