

A guide to using the courts and facilities of Camberley LTC

Entering the courts

For courts 1, 2 and 3 use the gates on court 1.

For courts 4 and 5 (and court 3 if 1 and 2 are in use) use the top gate, accessed by going out of the main clubhouse gate and walking up the side of the hedge. The key for the gate is located on the back wall of the clubhouse (a large wooden key fob). Always lock the gate and return the key if you are the last to leave courts 4 or 5.

General tennis etiquette

You should never walk across the back of a court when someone else is playing. Always wait until the end of a game and then check it is ok to cross.

To avoid accidents, always move stray balls from your court before playing a point.

Court sweeping and maintenance

The clay courts are to be swept at the start of any session, unless wet. The brushes are located at the back of the courts. Sweep from the outer edge of the court with concentric circles until reaching the middle. More details are on the clubhouse noticeboard.

Dress code

Players are to wear tennis/sports clothing and shoes appropriate for the court surface.

Guests

Members are allowed up to two playing guests on any one occasion and each guest may play a maximum of three times in a year. Guest names should be entered in the visitor's book (located in the clubhouse, next to the computer). A fee of £5/adult and £3/junior should be placed in the postbox on the wall next to the visitor book or paid direct to the club account.

The Clubhouse

If you use the kitchen, toilets, etc. it is the member's responsibility to keep the facilities tidy and clean. Please wash up and put away any used cups etc.

All litter including tennis ball cans should be placed in the bins provided.

If you are the last to leave, remember to switch off all clubhouse lights and heaters.

Floodlights

These are operated by the switches on the back wall near the computer. Only switch on the courts that you need and always switch off when you finish if you are the last to leave. All lights are programmed to go off at 10.00pm. If this happens, you must still switch off at the mains before you leave.
