#### **Pickleball**

Members have free use of two outdoor Pickleball courts including paddles and balls. They can also take part in any outdoor club sessions and tournaments.

During the Winter we also play indoor in the Village Hall with a fee payable by all participants to share the cost of the hire.

Non-members can also join the club sessions, both indoor and outdoor, as a guest for a fee of £5 per person per session.

#### **Competitive Tennis:**

If you are competitive, then there are regular intra-club tournaments, Winter & Summer Club Championships, and organised club sessions. We also enter Mens Doubles, Ladies Doubles and Mixed Doubles teams in the Dorking & Leatherhead summer league.

# (\*) Instalment Option

The Club has decided to introduce an instalment option for the payment of certain categories of membership subscription as noted above. Under the instalment options, payment should be made by standing order of £32.50 per month for six months (or £65) per month for two-adult family membership) with the first payment being made on 1st April 2024 and the sixth and final payment being made on 1st September 2024. Standing orders can be set up easily within most electronic banking apps.

In the event of an instalment payment being missed, then the instalment option will be withdrawn from the member in question and the balance of the year's subscription will become payable in full. All membership rights (including playing in matches and tournaments) will be withdrawn until full payment has been made.

Other than those paying by instalments, full payment of your membership renewal fees for the coming season are due on or before 1<sup>st</sup> April 2024.

<u>Please note that, whilst we have the instalment option, the Club, would prefer full payment by 1 April if possible.</u>

#### **Junior and Intermediate membership**

Junior and Intermediate players must be Club Members before they can take part in coaching sessions.

# **Joining Capel Tennis Club**:

On application all potential new members will be asked to indicate their playing standard to enable us to help them to get the best out of their membership. There are three categories:

Beginners new to tennis, not yet able to play a game	
Improvers	a bit rusty but returning to tennis or dabbled and want to improve their skills
Club Standard	a tennis player able to play in club sessions

All members have full access to the club facilities and social events.

**Beginners** will receive one free coaching session with our Club Coach to advise them how best to use the ball machine, practice wall and courts to develop their game until the coach agrees that

they have reached **Improvers** standard. They can also discuss with the Club Coach 1-2-1 sessions, paid to the coach, to help their development.

**Improvers** will be encouraged to join the Monday and Friday evening free coaching sessions and will receive one free coaching session with our Club Coach to advise them how best to use the ball machine, practice wall and courts to develop their game until the coach agrees that they have reached **Club Standard**. They can also discuss with the Club Coach 1-2-1 sessions, paid to the coach, to help their development.

**Club Standard** players will be able to play in all club sessions and events as well as attending the free group coaching.

All applications are accepted once approved by the committee and the playing category is confirmed following an assessment by the coach or a committee member.

#### **Court Keys and Padlock Code:**
