Potential Hazards	Action to Take
Lack of hand washing facilities	<p>All players must bring a hand sanitizer/gel/spray for their own use to be used before and after play.</p> <p>Hands should be washed with soap for 20 seconds before leaving home and as soon as possible after play.</p>
Loss of social distancing	<p>Doubles play is allowed</p> <p>Max 4 people per court (they do not have to be from the same household.)</p> <p>Group coaching, up to six players on the court including the coach can participate in a coaching/training session</p> <p>All courts to be booked in advance via the club website with a 15 minute break between bookings</p> <p>Avoid changing ends or change at opposite sides of the net</p> <p>Maintain 2m distance from your opponent at all times</p> <p>Only courts 1 and 3 will be available for play</p>
Viral transmission	<p>Only handle your own racket and personal marked tennis balls.</p> <p>Avoid touching the net and posts if at all possible</p> <p>Do NOT play if you are self isolating</p> <p>No shaking hands</p> <p>The clubhouse will remain closed</p>
Protect the public	<p>Access to the courts will be via a combination padlock.</p> <p>The code will change each week and will be given to the booking player.</p> <p>The combination padlock should be sanitised when leaving</p>
Lack of understanding	<p>A poster displaying the rules regarding playing tennis during the Covid pandemic will be displayed outside the clubhouse.</p>
