Potential Hazards	Action to Take
Lack of hand washing facilities	All players must bring a hand sanitizer/gel/spray for their own use to be used before and after play. Hands should be washed with soap for 20 seconds before leaving home and as soon as possible after play.
Loss of social distancing	Doubles play is allowed Max 4 people per court (they do not have to be from the same household.) Group coaching, up to six players on the court including the coach can participate in a coaching/training session All courts to be booked in advance via the club website with a 15 minute break between bookings Avoid changing ends or change at opposite sides of the net Maintain 2m distance from your opponent at all times Only courts 1 and 3 will be available for play
Viral transmission	Only handle your own racket and personal marked tennis balls. Avoid touching the net and posts if at all possible Do NOT play if you are self isolating No shaking hands The clubhouse will remain closed
Protect the public	Access to the courts will be via a combination padlock. The code will change each week and will be given to the booking player. The combination padlock should be sanitised when leaving
Lack of understanding	A poster displaying the rules regarding playing tennis during the Covid pandemic will be displayed outside the clubhouse.
