

Code of practice for young people

As a young person attending Charlton Kings Tennis Place, you are expected to abide by the following code of practice:

- Be friendly, supportive and welcoming to other children and adults
- Play fairly and honestly
- Respect club staff, volunteers and officials and accept their decisions
- Behave, respect and listen to your coach
- Wear suitable kit for training sessions and matches, as agreed with the coach
- Take care of your equipment and club property
- Arrive promptly for training and competitions and inform your coach or team manager if you are going to be late
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, culture, religion or sexual identity
- Not use bad, inappropriate or racist language, including on social media
- Not bully, intimidate or harass anyone, including on social media
- Not smoke, drink alcohol or drugs of any kind on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions or events
- Talk to the club Welfare Officer about any concerns or worries they have about themselves or others.
