## EVENT INFORMATION

### Winners of the Fred Perry Championships finals will receive:

- One-year Fred Perry clothing supply – exclusive to 2022 winners only.
- A specially commissioned Gold Medal.

### The Runners-up of the Fred Perry Championships finals will receive:

- A specially commissioned Silver Medal.

### All participants receive:

- Regional Qualifying Events: All players will receive their own unique Fred Perry black champagne tennis balls.
- Finals Event: All players will receive their own Fred Perry t-shirt and sweatband.

The Fred Perry Tennis program continues to grow, with a focus on creating opportunities for youngsters at all levels to play tennis.

### WORLD-CLASS COACHING CLINIC:

All participating players at the Finals event will receive a complimentary invite to a world-class tennis coaching clinic, hosted by Dan Bloxham (Head Coach at the All-England Club Wimbledon), who will be assisted by past Fred Perry Championship alumni winners, and other leading coaches. The coaching clinic will take place at 9am on Sunday 11th September 2022 and will be structured to accommodate those playing in the main draw, and the consolation on that day.

For all qualifiers, entries will open on Tuesday 19th July at 00:00 and will close at Tuesday 23rd August 10:00 with withdrawal deadline Mon 29 Aug 10:00.

Entries for the Finals open on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> July and close at 10:00 on Saturday 29th August. Withdrawal deadline also at 10:00 on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> August.

### ENTRY FEES:

Regional Qualifying Events: **£5**

Finals Event: **£5**

All entry fees will go to the Fred Perry Trust, aiding the refurbishment of public tennis courts around the country.

Please enter through the LTA website: Finals Event MID-22-0509; Nottingham Regional Qualifying Event NOT-22-0133 (All Ages); Manchester- Wythenshaw Regional Qualifying LAN-22-0198 (14U and 16U); Manchester- Heyes Grove Regional Qualifying Event CHE-22-0214 (11U and 12U); Brighton/Hove- Hove Park Regional Qualifying Event SUS-22-0220 (14U and 16U); Brighton/Hove- Hollingbury Regional Qualifying Event SUS-22-0297 (11U and 12U).

Players may only play in one age group in the Finals Event (all events will be played concurrently). If any player is entered into more than one age group at the withdrawal deadline, the referee will remove them from the entry list of the older age group. The top 9 ranked players entering the Finals Event will be directly accepted and should withdraw from any Regional Qualifying Event they have entered.

The winner and runner-up of each Regional Qualifying Event will qualify to play in the Finals Event. Any Qualifier not already entered into the Finals event will be entered manually and sent an invoice for the entry fee on confirmation that they wish to play in the Finals Event.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Finals Event draw will comprise of 9 direct acceptances (the 9 highest ranked entrants) and the winner and runner up of each Regional Qualifying Event, as well as one Wildcard. In the event of any player qualifying for the Finals Event not taking up their place, or the Wildcard not being allocated, the place will be allocated to the player at the top of the Finals Event reserve list.
- Scoring in the Regional Qualifying Events will be FAST4. In the Finals Event it will be 2 sets and a Match Tie Break replacing the 3rd set. The Compulsory Consolation at the Finals Event will be played using FAST4 scoring.
- Surfaces at each venue may vary.
- All matches will be photographed, and the 8 Finals at the Finals Event will be live streamed on Fred Perry social channels.
- All events will consist of a 16 player draw for both boys and girls in each age group. The Regional Qualifying Events and The Finals Event will be an Elimination Draw with a Compulsory Consolation.
