CHISELDON TENNIS CLUB ANTI-DOPING (DRUGS) POLICY

Background

Chiseldon Tennis Club supports and is bound by the LTA Anti-Doping Regulations which form part of the LTA Disciplinary Code effective 1st April 2022.

These apply to players and any support personnel. This includes Volunteers. Where the use of drugs does not fall within the remit of the anti-doping regulations it may constitute misconduct under the LTA Disciplinary Code. Concerns should be reported in accordance with this policy.

Responsibility

In particular, each player must know and abide by the Anti-Doping Regulations, policies and practices, and is solely responsible for what they ingest or use.

Banned substances

These are itemised on the Prohibited List updated on 1 January each year by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

The list includes medications and methods, including social drugs.
