Chobham & District Lawn Tennis Club (CADLTC) is strongly committed to encouraging our members to participate in all our activities as a club, but the health, well-being, and safety of each individual and each other is always our paramount concern.

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY:

To support our Health and Safety policy statement the Club's Management Committee is committed to the following duties:

- Appoint a Committee member to oversee all health and safety responsibilities.
- Undertake regular, recorded risk assessment of the club premises and all activities undertaken by the club.
- Create a safe environment by putting health and safety measures in place as identified by an annual risk assessment.
- To maintain the clubhouse and courts to an appropriate standard to minimize and mitigate risk of personal injury.
- To keep up to date with Government, Local Authority and LTA Health and Safety quidelines.
- Ensure that appropriate Health and Safety information is provided to members and that suitable posters and signage are in place on the club's premises.
- Ensure that all members are made aware of and are fully encouraged to follow the club's health and safety policy.
- Establish, and regularly review, operating procedures for use in cases of emergency.
- Provide access to adequate first aid resources with supplies reviewed regularly.
- Maintain a written record of any injuries or accidents sustained by any person (whether member of not) during any club activity or whilst on the club premises.
- Ensure that the implementation of this policy is reviewed regularly and monitored for effectiveness.

NOTE: CADLTC are unable to provide the same policies to members of the public using our courts during public times and where courts are booked through the Parish Office.

AS A CLUB MEMBER YOU HAVE A DUTY TO:

- Take reasonable care of your own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by what you do or not do.
- To keep up to date with all Health and Safety guidance issued by the club and to ensure adherence to all Health and Safety measures introduced by the club.
- Co-operate with the club on Health and Safety issues.
- Use all equipment provided by the club in an appropriate and safe manner.
- Not interfere with or misuse anything provided for your health, safety or welfare.
- Record any accidents where personal injury has occurred in the Accident Book, located in the First Aid Kit in the clubhouse.
