USE OF CHANGING ROOM POLICY

Cocks and Hens Cambridge Tennis strives to ensure that all children (anyone under 18) are safeguarded from abuse and have an enjoyable tennis experience.

This policy applies to all staff, coaches, volunteers, players, parents/carers and any other individuals associated with Cocks and Hens Cambridge Tennis.

It remains the parents' and/or carers' responsibility to decide whether it is safe and appropriate to allow their unaccompanied child to use the Club's changing rooms and toilets. Please consider your child's general development and maturity, their awareness of the potential risks, and that the Club is unable to provide supervision of these facilities.

This document sets out the Club's policy for the acceptable use of our changing rooms.

1. Cocks and Hens Cambridge has male and female changing rooms available.
2. The Club does not have separate changing and showering facilities for adults and children. We recommend that junior members come to the Club already changed and go home afterwards to change and shower.
3. Adult staff, coaches or volunteers should avoid changing or showering whilst children are using the changing rooms.
4. Where possible, adults should avoid being alone in the changing room with children.
5. If we are made aware that a child or adult self-identifies as a gender that differs from the gender they were assigned at birth, we will work with them and their parents/carers (where it relates to a child) to make reasonable adjustments to changing arrangements to suit their needs.
- 6. Mobile phones, cameras or any other recording devices must not be used in changing rooms at any time.**
