### **4.0 Tennis and Coaching Programme**

#### **General Play**

New members are offered a "buddy", if required, who will help introduce them to existing members and mixing in with both social and team play. Arrange to be met at the Club with your buddy for your initial visits to ensure you have a warm welcome and meet existing members.

All levels of mixed abilities regularly play throughout the year, just turn up and join in!

The club has Ladies' and Men's teams of differing levels of ability in many Midlands' leagues. Similarly, there is a healthy Junior competition programme directed by coaching staff.

League Matches take place throughout the year with most matches played between April and September. We compete in the Birmingham Area League and Coventry & District League. Team entries include men's and ladies along with veteran's tennis for men's, ladies, and mixed teams.

We also run annual club Championships culminating in a trophy–presentation evening. For those not wishing to be involved in that level of competition, social and beginners' tennis is of course available all year round.



#### **Coaching Programme**

A Star Tennis provide the coaching services at our club. They are a small company who also serve Hampton-in-Arden and Solihull Arden Tennis clubs. Coaching arrangements are between A Star and members. Cost of coaching is set by A Star Tennis.

#### **6.0 Non-Members / Visitors**

Non-Member / Visitors are very welcome when playing with a full member.

We allow visits by a prospective member over a period of 8 weeks after which a nonmember should apply for membership to continue playing. Visitor fees are  $\pounds$ 2 per visit. Deducted from the membership fee if subsequently deciding to join. The membership date starts from the date of the first visit. Pro-rated membership is offered if a new member joins part way through the season.

During this trial period, non-members are unable to sign in visitors or play in our annual Club tournaments.



### 7.0 Social Events

We have an active social programme that includes a variety of things to cater for all. It is a great way to meet people and support the club's fund-raising efforts throughout the year. Dates are advertised on the clubhouse main notice board, on the club website and via social media and email.

### 8.0 History of Coleshill Tennis Club

Coleshill is in North Warwickshire on a ridge between the rivers Cole and Blythe which converge to the north with the River Tame. It is situated 10 miles east of Birmingham, 9 miles southeast of Sutton Coldfield, 11 miles south of Tamworth, 13 miles northwest of Coventry and 13 miles west of Nuneaton.

The club dates to the late 19th century and was founded in 1884. The original site was in the garden of the Cant family which is now the doctor's surgery in Parkfield Road. The Cant family had a long-standing relationship with the club with Doctor Isobel Cant being President well into the 1980s.

The club now occupies the same grounds, due East of Coleshill Church, that it purchased from a local landowner in 1927 for the regal sum of one hundred and forty pounds. The clubhouse in those days was merely comprised of a wooden pavilion, which survived well into the 1980s.

In 1982, club members provided extensive labour, and skills to build the present clubhouse. In 1998 the club received Lottery funding which enabled purchase of additional land, 2 additional tennis courts, floodlights and court resurfacing.

Refurbished in 2019, the clubhouse comprises a single-storey building, bar facilities, lounge area and changing rooms. It boasts one of the best views of any tennis club, overlooking the unspoilt countryside of the Blythe Valley. There are now four artificial grass and one artificial clay courts, all floodlit.

Trustees govern the tennis club, with a committee of volunteers administering daily. We have affiliation to The Lawn Tennis Association but receive no funding or grants from this body or any other source. Membership subscription, supported from the provision of the bar enables us to finance our club.

A professional company provide coaching for the club. Please refer to our coaching section for more information.

The club remains a small, not–for-profit, friendly club, run by members for members. Funding is generated from membership subscriptions and bar profit.


