DIARY DATES FOR 2019

Opening of Season: Saturday 6 April: 2pm American Tournament (Seniors & Intermediates), weather permitting, followed by a social event in the evening.

Social Tennis: Saturdays 2 – 5 pm; Monday and Wednesday evenings from 6 pm and Thursday mornings from 10.00 am. We will let you know of the arrangements for social tennis nights when the Men's and Ladies' league matches are playing at home.

An adult group plays on **Wednesday mornings** from 10 – 12 and would welcome new members. This is a very friendly group who would like to encourage people who have played in the past or who have never played and would like to join them for coffee and light exercise. Exercise is the main aim but they also enjoy a chat!

Team Practice: From Sunday 31 March until league matches start - Men on Sunday mornings at 9.00am and on Tuesday evenings starting at 6.00pm; Women on Sundays from 12.00 – 1.30pm.

Senior Championships: Start mid-June.

Finals Day: Saturday 31 August (keep this date free, you never know you could be playing! and, if not, your support is always welcome). This will be followed by a social 'do' in the clubhouse in the evening.

Social Events: Keep an eye on the clubhouse noticeboard and the website for information (typically: American Tournaments, BBQ, Wine & Cheese, Carry Out Nights, Christmas party night).

JUNIORS

Our club junior programme offers a variety of activities aimed at ensuring that our younger members get the most out of their membership, including supervised sessions, tournaments, competitions, teams in the East of Scotland Leagues and reduced prices for coaching sessions with our club coaches.

Remember that juniors are only allowed access to the **clubhouse** when an adult is present.

Junior Supervised Sessions: are normally held on Saturday afternoons throughout the year (weather permitting) – further information to follow.

Tournament Day: Sunday 25 August

'Playing Up': Juniors who would like to participate in adult tennis sessions, including adult team play, and are of a high enough standard are positively encouraged to join as **Intermediate** members.

We continue to develop our provision for juniors and have set up a junior committee with specific tasks being allocated to individuals. **For further information, and any parents willing to help** with junior activities **please** contact Nick Clark. **Assistance is always welcome!**

COACHING

Various **coaching sessions** will be provided throughout the year by Bruce Beadle, an experienced LTA coach and Chris Leonard, a level 2 LTA coach. These will be sessions for Adult beginners and Adult intermediates. Sessions for age grouped Juniors run throughout the year in addition to Easter and Summer camps. USE OF COURTS

Each category of club membership gives different access to the courts and club balls. Notwithstanding the access times stated below, any Full Adult, Intermediate, Restricted Adult or Junior member may use a vacant court at any time provided they vacate the court when requested by a member who has priority use. Morning members however, may only use the courts on 1 morning. For activities such as a box league tie, a tournament tie, an arranged game with other member(s) or guest(s) must be booked by individual members. It is a very simple process - there is a link on the Corstorphine tennis club website under the section 'use of courts' then you just log in using Ita login information. Even easier - there is a clubspark booking app for your phone.

Balls are made available for all the official social tennis sessions. On completion of play, balls must be returned to the box in the clubhouse for use at the next club session. At other times all members are welcome to use the used balls in the basket or the ball dispenser.

DAY	TIME	RULE
MONDAY & TUESDAY	UP TO 6PM	1. Full Adult, U25, Intermediate, Restricted Adult, Junior members. All these categories may use a court in turn. This means playing a short set (maximum 30 minutes) and then vacating the court if other members are waiting to play.
	FROM 6PM	2. Full Adult, U25 and Intermediate members play social tennis. This means that the first 4 members at the club play a short set. Other members go on court in order of arrival and also play a short set. On completion of a short set the court shall be vacated if others are waiting. If others are not waiting, further games may be played until another court has finished when the members shall mix up for a further set. After members have played one set in order of their arrival, the composition of following sets shall be determined by ballot subject to those members who have been waiting longest having priority to make up a set. Where the foregoing rules would result in 1 man making up a set with 3 ladies, or 1 lady making up a set with 3 men, the single man or lady may opt to wait for a later set.
WEDNESDAY	UP TO 12PM	3. Morning members play social tennis using 3 courts if required. Morning members may invite Full Adult and Restricted Adult members to play at this session.
	12PM TO 6PM	4. Use as described at 1 above.
	FROM 6PM	5. Use as described at 2 above.
THURSDAY	10.00AM - 12.00	6. Use as described at 2 above.
		7. Use as described at 1 and 2 above.
FRIDAY		8. Full Adult, U25, Intermediate, Restricted Adult, Junior members. Use as described at 1 above. (Note Juniors have access after 6pm and Full Adult, U25 and Intermediate Members do not have any priority time from 6pm.)
SATURDAY & SUNDAY	UP TO 12 PM	9. Juniors and Intermediates (and their parents if Full or Restricted Adult members who wish to play with their children) use the courts in turn. This means playing a short set (maximum 30 minutes) and then vacating the court if other members are waiting to play.
	12PM TO 2PM	10. Full Adult, U25 and Intermediate members may reserve a court for 1 hour (2 hours if courts are free) to play arranged sets with other Full Adult, U25 and Intermediate Members.
	2PM TO 5PM	11. Use as described at 2 above.
	5PM TO 7PM	12. Use as described at 8 above.
	FROM 7PM	13. Use as described at 1 above.

Morning Member: Play one morning each week	£50
Family Membership: Two adults and up to three children. Court usage as appropriate as defined above for Full Adults and Juniors.	£360

Fees for 2019 must be paid by 31 March 2019. Payments may be made electronically to the club's bank account, **Corstorphine Lawn Tennis Club sort code 80-02-27 a/c 00141641**, using your surname as reference. Alternatively, payment can be made by cheque, made payable to **Corstorphine Lawn Tennis Club**. Your membership fee also provides you with a key to the gate into the premises (1 key for each Senior or independent Junior member; or Family membership), plus a key to the clubhouse for adult members. These are issued by the Treasurer.

If not renewing your membership, please return your gate key and clubhouse key to the club.

Floodlight cards can be purchased for £4 – available from a number of members.

Prospective Adult members may play **once, free of charge**, at our weekend social tennis sessions before applying for membership.

Members may introduce **guests** to play at the club either at the social tennis sessions or for privately arranged games. The guest must be signed into the Guest Book and a **Guest's Fee** is payable by the member. The fee per visit is £4 for adults, £2 for intermediates and £1 for juniors. This should be put in an envelope with names on it and put through the hole in the ball cupboard door.

A member may bring a guest for an unlimited number of visits **for one month**, thereafter reverting to a maximum of two visits per month.

Corstorphine Lawn Tennis Club Privacy Notice

We, Corstorphine Lawn Tennis Club, are committed to protecting and respecting the privacy of all our members. We take the necessary measures to ensure that all personal information we collect and process is adequately safeguarded and handled sensitively and confidentially in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 and the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

This Privacy Notice sets out the basis on which we will process any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it. By completing a membership application form or by using our website, you are giving your consent to our using and processing your personal data in the way described in this policy.

For the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998 (the Act), the data controller is Corstorphine Lawn Tennis Club of 65 Belgrave Road, Edinburgh, EH126NQ, the operator of Corstorphine Lawn Tennis Club (the Club). Our nominated representative (Data Administrator) for the purpose of the Act is Neil Moncrieff.

Why we need your personal information

When you complete an application to join CLTC or renew your membership (including if you are registering a child under the age of 13) we will ask you for the following personal information and this will form a contractual basis between yourself and the club:

- Name, address, email address, and contact telephone numbers. Also, to determine their membership category we will ask for children's dates of birth.

We need to collect our member's personal information to enable us to administer our membership, offer services and carry out our aims and objectives. We may contact you to inform you of:

- Club matters
- Club competitions and tournaments
- Club social events
- Membership renewals

As an affiliated club of the Lawn Tennis Association we are required to ensure that all our members are members of the Lawn Tennis Association to participate in league matches and the Wimbledon ballot. We may also give the Lawn Tennis Association only your email address for the purpose of British Tennis Membership and the Wimbledon ballot.

We also process our Members' personal information in pursuit of our legitimate interests to:

- promote and encourage participation in tennis by sending members' communications and booking information for upcoming tournaments and events. These tournaments may be filmed or photographed and your personal information may also be used in images captured from our tournaments and events which we use for promotional, education and development purposes. Photographs will only be published on our clubhouse noticeboard, the club website and the club Facebook page. Photographs will not be passed to 3rd parties.
- Provide competition in tennis tournaments by accepting and managing entries for these and checking personal information to ensure you are entered in to the correct category. You will be asked to provide an email address or phone number if you enter club tournaments to enable tournament ties to be organised. This information will only be displayed on the clubhouse noticeboard for the duration of the tournament.

Where we process your personal information in pursuit of our legitimate interests, you have the right to object to us using your personal information for the above purposes. If you wish to object to any of the above processing please email the Data Administrator at moncr21@virginmedia.com or in writing to Corstorphine Lawn Tennis Club at the address given in the 3rd paragraph above in the first instance who will raise the matter with the Committee. If we agree and comply with your objection, this may affect our ability to undertake the above tasks for the benefit of you as a member.

Who we share your personal information with

We may be required to share personal information with statutory or regulatory authorities and organisations to comply with statutory obligations. Such organisations include Disclosure Scotland and Police Scotland for the purposes of safeguarding children and also the Health and Safety Executive, for issues relating to Health and Safety. In relation to the latter, where a personal accident or injury is recorded in the accident book held in the clubhouse, this will be retained securely in order that the club has a record of all incidents in line with Health and Safety requirements.

How long we keep your personal information

We will only keep your personal information for a period of 6 months beyond the current membership year and then it will be destroyed with appropriate safeguards. This will include shredding paper-based records and permanently deleting electronic records to prevent recovery.

Personal information is also held electronically on the Members' page of the club website and contains the name, address, telephone number and email address of club members. Access to the Members' page is password protected and the password will be changed periodically. Members are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We may share your information held on the Members page with other members of the Club who wish to organise competitions, leagues or to arrange matches with you. By completing a competition, league or other event entry form, you consent to the use of such information for these purposes.

Your rights in relation to your personal information are:

- You have a right to request access to the personal information that we hold about you by making a "subject access request";
- If you believe that any of your personal information is inaccurate or incomplete, you have a right to request that we correct or complete your personal information;
- You have a right to request that we restrict the processing of your personal information for specific purposes;
- If you wish us to delete your personal information, you may request that we do so.

You can exercise any of the following rights by emailing the Data Administrator at moncr21@virginmedia.com or in writing to Corstorphine Lawn Tennis Club at the address given in the 3rd paragraph above. Any requests received by Corstorphine Lawn Tennis Club will be considered under applicable data protection legislation and a response provided within one month. If you remain dissatisfied, you have a right to raise a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office at <https://ico.org.uk/>
