Adult Members, Volunteers, Coaches and Visitors

- Be a positive role model and act with integrity
- Be patient with those who require extra help with understanding the rules and playing the game
- Ensure new people feel welcome

Children and Young People

- Behave, respect and listen to your coach
- Play fairly
- Be the best that you can on court
- Use positive language
- Take care of your equipment and club property
- Help with clearing up when asked

Parents and Carers

- Be positive with your child about their play
- Encourage your child to play by the rules, and teach them that they can only do their best
- Provide emergency contact details and any relevant information about your child
