Changing Room Policy

Craighelen LT&SC wishes to provide safe and inclusive changing facilities for all members and visitors to the club.

This document sets out the Craighelen policy for the acceptable use of our changing rooms.

1. The club does not have separate changing and showering facilities for adults and children. We ask that junior members come to the club already changed, wearing suitably warm clothing e.g. tracksuits, and go home afterwards to change and shower.
2. Juniors will be encouraged to use the disabled toilet facilities if unaccompanied by an adult.
3. Children should be supervised by a parent or guardian if entering the changing rooms.
4. Under no circumstances will adult staff, coaches or volunteers change or shower at the same time as children using the changing rooms.
5. If we are made aware that a child or adult self-identifies as a gender that differs from the gender that they were assigned at birth, we will work with them and their parents/carers (where it relates to a child) to make reasonable adjustments to changing arrangements to suit their).
