CLTC Open Day success

Thanks to everyone who contributed to making the CLTC Open day on 24th September a huge success!

"The open day had over 30 adults and 40 children taking part from all ages and standards.

As it was an Autumn Open Day, we used the dome to house the adult session. This went down really well with a proactive nucleus of players that thought the dome was an amazing facility. This proved to be a great catalyst in people's decision to join. We certainly had more membership take up than in the Summer. This formed the idea of introducing a coach hosted club session in which Craig is really looking forward to being involved in.

We also signed up 12 junior players into the programme directly from the Open day. This was an amazing result and the club now has a junior programme nearing 200 players. We have adapted the programme for the next half term to introduce newly defined playing standards and scheduling sessions that utilises the courts more, without taking more indoor court time. This will enable us to grow the programme through to the end of the year and beyond.

Club Etiquette

Do close the gate behind you when entering a court: Whether you're coming onto the courts, or leaving, it is common courtesy to close a gate behind you, which will keep the ball inside the confines of the court so that they don't roll outside. Also, when entering the dome, do avoid interrupting play when accessing your court by waiting till play stops.

Code of Conduct

This is the **fourth and fifth** codes in our Code of Conduct series:

These Codes of Conduct, or tennis etiquette, are based on good practice developed by the Lawn Tennis Association around the standards and values expected to be adopted by tennis clubs around the country.

4. Close any gates behind you:

Whether you're coming onto the courts, or leaving, it is common courtesy to close a gate behind you. This will keep the balls inside the confines of the court so that they don't roll outside.

5. Treat other members with dignity and respect:

Dignity is about being respectful, responsible and behaving fairly. So, avoid any inappropriate actions, behaviour or comments which may cause offence, mental or physical anxiety e.g. racquet throwing, swearing, aggressive behaviour or any questioning of another person's integrity over line calls or other actions.

Member Question

Q. What are the arrangements to access the dome when the weather is too bad for outdoor play?

A. The dome is booked via Clubspark and is dependent on availability. The cost is \pounds 12 per court per hour for members.

The coaching timetable has been circulated. This identifies when the dome is in use for formal coaching activities.

During winter only, 2 courts are booked for club and social sessions on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 7.30pm.

Mon & Weds am hosts can book the dome for club session 48 hrs in advance.

All club sessions in the dome are charged at $\pounds4$ per person per session.

If a member/host books a dome court but play is facilitated outdoors, the member/host must cancel their dome booking. If your question is not answered fully, please contact: <u>Bookings@crawleyltc.co.uk</u>
