

FAMILY MEMBERSHIP & KEY POLICY JUNE 2016

Family membership is defined as: -

Two adults (parents or grandparents) plus up to three related children aged 18 years or under. Over 18 they must join in their own right, either as students (if at school or in full-time education) or as adults. Student is defined as 19-22 years old.

Policy effective immediately for new joiners.

KEY POLICY

Court keys are only issued to adult members. However, in the case of family members, they may be passed to student members over the age of 16 years on condition that the responsibility for them remains with the adult members of the family.

Therefore, keys are issued on the basis that they will be under the control of the adult member. To comply with our insurance policy, the key will always be the responsibility of the adult member, whether used/held by the student or not.

To comply with our premises insurance policy, junior members up to 18 years old may not be issued with a key.
