Nexus Junior Tennis Tour and Nexus Winter Series

Competition Rules (From 01/09/2020)

Nexus Junior Tennis Tour leading to the Masters Finals

- 1. All players competing in the Nexus Junior Tennis Tour 12 & Unders or 16 & Unders will be awarded points towards an online 'leaderboard'. The leaderboards will be published on Facebook after each event during the season (depending on results being received).
- 2. All Nexus Junior Tennis Tour titled events within Devon in the competition schedule each season will count towards the leaderboard. The Tour will run from January to September.
- 3. The 12 & Under event is mixed, open to boys and girls. 12 & Under players will be in ratings bands 9 and 10, no one with a rating higher than 9.1 will be eligible to enter. The 16 & Under event is boys only and for 16 & Under players the ratings cap is 8.1.
- 4. *12U players will be a 9 or 10 rating in the* first event they play and if their rating goes up during the leaderboard season they will still be eligible to play in all events during that season.
- 5. Players will get 10 points for every match they play and receive an additional 40 points for every match won.
- 6. Only a maximum of **3** matches in each competition will count for leaderboard points and where extra matches above this number are played, it is only the first 3 matches that will count towards the leaderboard.
- 7. Results from the player's top **seven** competitions played will go towards their final total (not a cumulative total of all points received). At the end of the Yellow Ball Circuit there will be a Masters final for up to the top 8 players on both the 12 & Under and 16 & Under leaderboards. There will be prizes for the winners and runners up.
- 8. Players can enter as many Nexus Junior Tennis Tour leaderboard events as they wish. However, in order to qualify for the Masters Finals, players must have competed in a minimum of **5** events at their age group. (Whirlwind is 6)
- 9. If the situation arises where we do not have 8 players who have played the minimum of 5 competitions, we will look at the player with the next highest number of points who has played a minimum of 3 events.
- 10. If the leaderboard is drawn in any position, selection will be made based on the player with the highest average number of points across the top 5 competitions. If all players remain equal, the player's name will be drawn from a hat.
- 11. Please note the Nexus Tour is not aimed at those players regularly competing in higher grade events or who are regularly invited to County Training.





Nexus Winter Series

- 1. This a new series of Grade 6 events running which will run each year from September to December. They will be one off events.
- 2. Please note there will <u>not</u> be a leaderboard or Masters finals with the winter series. They are stand alone events.
- 3. The 12 & Under event is mixed, open to boys and girls. 12 & Under players will be in ratings bands 9 and 10, no one with a rating higher than 9.1 will be eligible to enter. The 16 & Under event is boys only and the 16 & Under ratings cap is 8.1.
- 4. The 'number/rating' you are on the day of the competition will determine if you are able to play in that event.
- 5. The 12&U and 16&U events will be run to a conclusion on the day with a winner. The format of each event will vary depending on the number of entries, venue, court time etc
- 6. The recommended scoring at each event is:

Fast4 Format

- Best of three sets
- First to four games wins
- At 3 games all a tie-break is played to 7 points, 2 clear at 6-6
- If the score reaches 1 set all, a match tie-break is played to 10 points, 2 clear at 9-9
- No ad scoring. If the score reaches deuce, it's a sudden death point with the receiver choosing the side.

But please note this may be subject to change at the discretion of the individual organiser.
