# **Buildings and Grounds**

- 1. Tennis courts Quotes from Sportex and DOE were discussed in Tennis.
- 2. Robertsons completed the electrical work required.
- 3. Squash noticeboard light requires repair.
- 4. There was a leak in squash viewing area, when the gutter backed up in heavy rain. Stewart cleared the gutter and it has been fine since.
- 5. Halliday have not come back to check lux levels on courts.

#### **Finance**

Bernie provided a brief summary of the current state of bank balances. Income from summer camp was £11,452 which included £1,153 of non-member fees. Bernie also deducted 50% of what Mark owes for 2021 (£783) and paid the balance to Mark. Mark was advanced £10,000 of current block fees as agreed, with balance to be paid at end of block in October once all fees are collected.

## Membership

There are currently 566 members. 2 people are being chased for payment. 2 Ukrainian children have signed up for tennis coaching.

#### **Tennis**

Ladies 1<sup>st</sup> team won Division 1, with 2<sup>nd</sup> team coming 3<sup>rd</sup>. 3<sup>rd</sup> team finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in div 3. Ladies O45 1st team won their league with 2nds coming 6th. Mens 1<sup>st</sup> team came 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>'s 3<sup>rd</sup> in div 2 and 3<sup>rd</sup> team 5<sup>th</sup> in div3. Mens singles 1<sup>st</sup> team are top and 2<sup>nd</sup>'s 5<sup>th</sup> at present. O55 teams came 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>.

U16 1<sup>st</sup> team came 5<sup>th</sup> in div 1 and 2<sup>nd</sup>,'s 4<sup>th</sup> in div 2. U12 1st team won the league and 2nds are 2<sup>nd</sup> with one match to play.

Mens 1<sup>st</sup> team are entering the National League.

Club championship will need Board members to open up, turn lights on and close up. A rota will be issued as in previous years. Kirsty is taking money for juniors entering Junior championships. Emma will check with Kirsty on prizes, probably medals. Adult winners will receive balls.

LTA Venue Registration requires completing – Stewart will do.

**Tennis Courts** – Stewart will email members to inform them of the Board's decision to lay artificial clay court surface. Quote from Sportex was reasonably priced and will be held for 30 days. Courts

will be resurfaced in about March 2023 and installation will take 4-5 weeks. Brick wall at side of courts has previously been waterproofed so is fine.

### Squash

Bill will attend the Crieff and District AGM on 8<sup>th</sup> September. Team players will have their Scottish Squash affiliation fees paid together with charge to the Club of £100 for new SS Membership strategy. Other squash players will be informed that they can join SS as individual members at a cost of £15, which allows them a SportyHQ profile, enter competitions and leagues and have player insurance. The 2 Dunblane teams will be of equal ability this season.

Bill is running a handicap tournament beginning 26<sup>th</sup> September. Bernie and June Hegarty ran 3 Try Squash. sessions, with 6 ladies, I man and 1 family coming to junior session.

James has started Junior coaching but there was no interest in Adult coaching on Monday night.

#### Social

Wine tasting evening is on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> September, with a ticket price of £20 giving about £5 profit for the club. Nicola will email members informing them that tickets are available on Clubspark.

Nicola will check out catering vans for Finals day.
