ON COURT GUIDELINES

A list of Club Rules is on the notice board in the pavilion for the guidance of all members. You are asked to observe them in order to preserve the court surfaces and nets and to help maintain club standards for everyone's enjoyment.

In particular:

- Ensure correct footwear is worn (not ridged trainers or black marking soles)
- Wear reasonable tennis/sports clothing – denim jeans are not allowed
- Look after the courts
- Replace measuring sticks for nets on court benches and let down nets after play
- Lock the gate after use
- No chewing gum, food, alcohol or litter on the courts
- Only balls allowed on court are Tennis balls
- For your safety and in consideration of other players maximum 4 players on court – only

exception to this Guideline: formal club coaching sessions

- Club matches take priority and, in respect of visiting teams, all courts may be reserved during league matches – please check fixture list and booking system on the website
- Adult members have priority over Junior members
- Wait until an adjoining game is finished before asking to walk across their court
- Failure to observe these simple courtesy rules could lead to disciplinary action or membership being revoked
- Visitors are welcome but can only play 3 times in any one year and visitors' fees must be paid. Your visitor's behaviour on court is your responsibility - please abide by the rules.
- Please also note visitors will only be covered by club insurance if their names have been entered into the Visitors' Book in Pavilion Notice box and the relevant fee paid.
