- Bound by and subject to the Rules and Disciplinary Code of England Squash.

Members are expected to:

- Conduct themselves in a correct and proper manner demonstrating the sports values of “Fair Play, Enjoy and Respect” by always maintaining a level of excellence and integrity; including, but not limited to, by not doing anything which brings The Club, the LTA, Bowls England or England Squash or the member themselves into disrepute.
- Take responsibility in ensuring they are up to date with the Club Rules, understand those Rules and adhere to them. The Club Rules and Regulations can be viewed on the Club website.
- Behave in manner that sets a positive example for others. Bullying or any sort of abuse will not be tolerated.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Respect The Club Executive and respective sports sub-committee and publicly accept their decisions.
- Treat and respect all equipment, officials, opposition and spectators and behave to them in a way they themselves would be expected to be treated.
- Not use inappropriate language or gestures.
- Not mess around or distract other players.
- Encourage everyone to enjoy sport and understand that people have different motivations for taking part.

Failure to follow the Code of Conduct may result in action being taken against a member and their membership may be subsequently terminated at the discretion of the Club Executive Committee.
