Club news

Tennis is back!

Court bookings can start from now with play due to start Wednesday 2 December 2020, morning.

A polite reminder to all that the clay & shale courts can not be used whilst defrosting or when puddled and please remember to sweep the court after each slot played on them!

Please remember and adhere to the following rules:

- Court bookings for singles / doubles Please use the court booking system as before, and it is vital that the other participants you are playing with are added to the booking - this is for Track & Trace purposes and to ensure fairness for all.
- Each member is limited to ONE slot per day after 4pm Monday Friday, and before 4pm Saturday & Sunday.
- Each member may play no more than THREE times a week after 4pm Monday Friday.
- Exception to this rule is, if on the day you see a court is free, you may book another slot, ie if I have a slot booked for Monday, Wednesday and Thursday already and on Wednesday morning and I see a slot free on that day, I can book that too! In these cases you MUST NOT play with

- more than 5 other people across the 2 slots remember the rule of 6.
- The clubhouse is only to be entered to put money into the lights box (best to put your money in before the previous slot runs out, due to light warm-up time.)
- Toilets are not to be used.
- Do not arrive earlier than 15 mins before your slot and leave straight afterwards.
- The bar will remain closed until further notice.

Calthorpe Estates and Development plan update

As you'll know by now, we are working on a development plan for the club, aiming to make more of our courts playable all year round. Karsten and Helen met Calthorpe Estates to discuss this plan and to raise the problem that not having a long-term lease causes us (i.e. we can't get any external funding). There have been similar conversations over the years so this is not a new issue and they are well aware!

The meeting was positive and we are due to meet again soon to discuss what options may be available to us - there is a fundamental clash of what the two sides want as we want a long-term lease that gives us security of tenure and they want to retain flexibility so that they can repurpose our land as part of a bigger redevelopment of the area if they want to - so it is not going to be easy to reach a compromise but there appears to be a willingness on both sides to do just that.
