

- If you notice that you are marking the courts, or damaging them in any way, please stop play.

Constitution Update

Helen held a Zoom meeting with members who were interested in discussing the liability issue in the Constitution and shared a summary of what had been done and found so far. Having talked through the pros and cons of the different legal entities, the consensus from the group was that the best course of action would be for the Society to remain as an unincorporated association (as opposed to e.g. a limited company) and to take steps to amend our Constitution to limit our liability.

The Constitution has now been redrafted with some additional clauses added and a few other minor amendments, as raised at the EGM in January. The Committee has approved seeking external legal advice from Brabners, the LTA's partner solicitors and a brief is being put together, in consultation with the working group. This is due to be reviewed and approved by the Committee at the next meeting on May 17th and we will then commence the process to formally engage Brabners.


