In memoriam: Lawrie Woodburn

One of the stalwarts of Archery during the sixties and early seventies passed away on 26 July, aged 83, following a fall in his garden in Arnside, Cumbria.

Lawrie Woodburn joined the club in 1962 and married Stephanie Bayliss in 1965. Stephanie's family had a long connection with the club. Her grandmother was a member prior to the Second World War and her family together with her aunt and uncle Kath and Desmond Robinson were largely responsible for running the club after the war and through to the late 1960's. Lawrie served on the committee as bar steward for a number of years, and was responsible for organising many of the social events during his time as a member. He was also keen on his tennis, winning the mixed doubles handicap championship on one occasion with Stephanie.

Although he left the club in 1972 to move to Arnside he will be remembered by many of our older members.
