As the autumn season kicks in, here is a reminder of the rules of play from now on:

The booking system in place for court bookings



- You are now again only allowed to book/play for 1 hour at peak times (after 5pm • weekdays and before 5pm weekends). If the court is free after your session, you can continue to play. Coaching sessions are not included in the restriction timings. (So, to clarify, if person A books doubles for A, B, C & D, then person B is not allowed to book for A, B, C & D the same evening). This is due to having less court time as the light fades and grass courts are closed.
- Group coaching sessions are bookable and payable online as usual •
- Please continue to book in advance for the Social mix-ins. The reason for keeping the booking system is so that we know who we can ask to organise, have an idea of numbers, and we can also contact those who have booked if there is an issue with the courts etc.


